OLD BUSINESS

708 MEATTE AVE.
Jonathan Thacker, Code Enforcement Officer, updated the Building Commission on the demolition and clean up due to Portageville Municipal Code violations at property owned by Barbara Toton located at 708 Meatte Ave. Michael Emery had completed demolition and clean up the lot. The concrete slab was left. This property is to be removed from the agenda for Building Commission.

216 US HWY 61 N
Jonathan Thacker, Code Enforcement Officer, approached the Building Commission regarding Portageville Municipal Code violations at property owned by Mike Allgier located at 216 US Hwy 61 North. This was the tenth, non-consecutive visit for the property. Thacker stated that Allgier continues to work on the property. Allgier was present and stated that the roof is the only item left of the structure to be completed to which Thacker


