OLD BUSINESS

DISPATCHING SERVICES

Mayor Pro-Tem Berry addressed the issue of fire department calls that come in to the Portageville Police Department now being required to be forwarded to New Madrid County Emergency Communication Center because of the Active 911 application used by the Fire Department. The signed Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Portageville,

Portageville Fire Chief and New Madrid County Emergency Communication Center was presented. Discussion followed. Alderman Essary presented the idea of all dispatching being done through New Madrid County based on the money that citizens already contribute through their tax dollars to the 911 program. The issue was tabled until the January 6, 2020 board meeting. In the meantime, if a call comes into the Police Department for a fire it is to be distributed through Textcaster first and then forwarded to New Madrid County. Mayor Pro-Tem Berry will try to speak with county officials before the board meeting to see about Portageville recouping some of the 911 funding since we are currently the backup dispatch for 911 in New Madrid County.

NEW BUSINESS

There was none.

PUBLIC FORUM

Mayor Pro-Tem Berry asked if there were any visitors present who would like to address the Board of Alderman.

Sam Tillman with H. Tillman Accountant, LLC addressed the Board of Alderman and stated that it was time to renew his current contract with the City of Portageville if they would like him to serve another three-year term ending May 31, 2024. Discussion followed. There are no changes to his rates. Motion was made by Alderman Doering and seconded by Alderman Berry to renew H. Tillman Accountant LLC for a three-year term ending May 31, 2024 with the City of Portageville at a rate of \$2300.00 per month. All members voted in favor.

Since we are a municipality, the City of Portageville is not required to pay anything over the federal minimum wage, but it is strongly suggested that we follow the Missouri minimum wage guidelines. The issue was tabled until the January 6, 2020 board meeting.
